

Immunization Certification Information

In accordance with Section 10a-155 of the Connecticut general statutes, all full time or matriculating students (born after December 31, 1956) must demonstrate proof of adequate immunization against measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) and varicella. Students that plan on residing on-campus must also demonstrate proof of a meningococcal vaccination.

ADEQUATE IMMUNIZATION ACCORDING TO STATE STATUTE

<u>Measles:</u> All new and readmitted students born **January 1, 1957or later** must provide proof of two (2) doses of measles vaccine-the doses should be separated by at least 28 days with dose number one given on or after the first birthday.

Mumps: All new and readmitted students born **January 1, 1957or later** must provide proof of two (2) doses of measles vaccine-the doses should be separated by at least 28 days with dose number one given on or after the first birthday.

<u>Rubella:</u> (German measles) All new and readmitted students born **January 1, 1957or later** must provide proof of two (2) doses of measles vaccine-the doses should be separated by at least 28 days with dose number one given on or after the first birthday.

<u>Varicella</u> (*As of August 2010*): All incoming freshmen are required to show proof of two (2) doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine- the doses should be separated by at least 28 days with dose number one given on or after the first birthday.

Note: Individuals born in the United States before January 1, 1980 are exempt to

this requirement.

<u>Meningococcal</u>: (Meningitis) Vaccine required for all students seeking on-campus residency.

STUDENTS REGISTERED AT ALBERTUS MAGNUS COLLEGE WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT DOCUMENTATION OF IMMUNIZATION PRIOR TO ATTENDING CLASSES AND/OR RESIDING IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS.

One of the following documents is necessary:

- A Medical Record
- ➤ A Physician's Statement
- ➤ Elementary or Secondary School Health Record
- Proof of Immune Titer

Appropriate documentation is required for a medical or religious exemption.
